**Message from Father Tom:**

**Thank you for all the Christmas cards and gifts!** I am so blessed by the way you all care for your priest. I feel very loved here at All-Saints and at St. Bernard's. As usual, I'm running behind on my thank you notes. I intend to get out as many as I can...but please be aware that in some cases there either was no name/address, or the name is so hard to read that I can't figure out to whom I should send the card.

**The Lord poured out His goodness upon me once again on retreat.** My takeaway is that the Lord will not be placed in a box. His ways are not our ways. Yet that also means that His love is unique and special to each one of us. I certainly experienced that unique, personal love this week.

**Regarding the clergy sex abuse crisis and its victims.** I have definitely not forgotten about the many souls affected by sinful priests and bishops. I suspect you all haven't either. And let us pray especially for the victims who are still in need of healing.

**Perhaps we should begin praying for our next bishop.** In the fall, Bishop Swain submitted his resignation to the Holy Father. Because this has not yet been accepted by the pope, I was holding off on beginning to pray for this intention. But as time goes on it seems like a better and better idea. Please pray that the Lord will give us a good and holy bishop appropriate to the challenges we face today. Let us pray also that we may love and respect him as the Lord calls us to do.

**DAY OF PRAYER FOR THE LEGAL PROTECTION OF UNBORN CHILDREN JANUARY 22, 2019**

The General Instruction of the Roman Missal, no. 373, designates January 22 as a particular day of prayer and penance, called the "Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children": "In all the Dioceses of the United States of America, January 22 (or January 23, when January 22 falls on a Sunday) shall be observed as a particular day of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion."
