Message from Father Tom:

"What are you looking for?"

This is one of the most interesting questions in scripture because it really makes us think. What is it that I really want. Sure there are many things that we want: I want that new video game, I want to do well with my work, I want to watch some TV, I want to hang out with my friends. But we can't even deceive ourselves into believing that this is enough for us. This man in the Gospel asks us what we are REALLY looking for.

When we think about it a little deeper we might answer that we are looking for a relationship or we are looking for a happy career. But that too seems like a means to an end-- a path that we seek in order to have what we really want. "What are you looking for?" How would you answer this question?

As we look around at the change of seasons and the changes of our lives we might finally answer that we are looking for meaning, or fulfillment, or peace amid the chaos of this life. We ultimately want to know that we are not alone in the cosmos.

This man, Jesus, speaks like no one else. He has a deep wisdom that goes to the soul. Maybe he has an answer to my desires. And so we, like James and John, want to learn from him..."where are you staying." Where can I listen to you and learn from you? Can you give me everything that I really want?

He answers us: "come and see!" Come and see who I am and what I have to teach you. If you don't come, you may never know. Christ is inviting us to really give Him a try. Spend time with Him in prayer in the chapel each day for 10-20 minutes; and allow Him to lead you to what you desire.

Please pray for our Confirmation students as they are getting closer to the reception of this wonderful sacrament on March 3rd. Pray their relationship with God is getting stronger with each day.

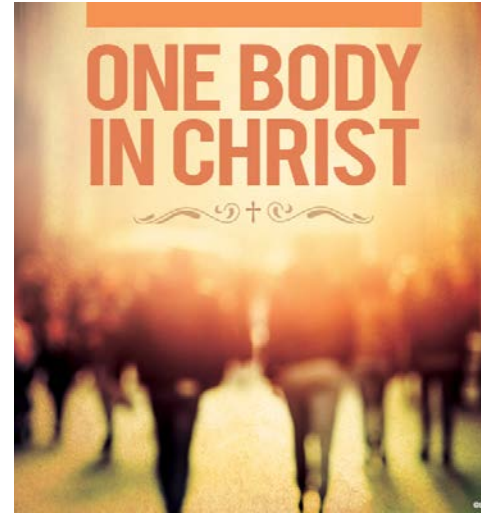
