**Message from Father Tom:**

Some time ago, I had the privilege of accompanying some of the young men from our diocese who are discerning their vocation-- specifically who are considering priesthood. The college seminary--where they are trained for this--is a lot like being in the army: it is very intense for the young men. These men share a radical determination that nothing is more important than serving Christ in everything. To them, Christ is King; and they are the soldiers of Christ. Also, like the army, there is a great emphasis on fraternity and brotherhood among the guys there. They genuinely care about one another, and lift each other up when life starts to drag them down.

This weekend is the great Feast of the Kingship of Christ. Truly, what separates us from the secular world, is that we have a King who is Lord over every aspect of our lives. Sometimes the Lord our king may even order us to do things we would rather not do. We are soldiers for our King, fighting in a world that would rather rebel against its king.

And like good soldiers, we must make it our effort to not leave any man (or woman) behind in the battle. Encourage each other; and strive always to inspire each other to greatness. Just like the seminarians, all of us in our respective parishes have the same King who reigns over us. And Christ the King has for all of us an incredible mission.

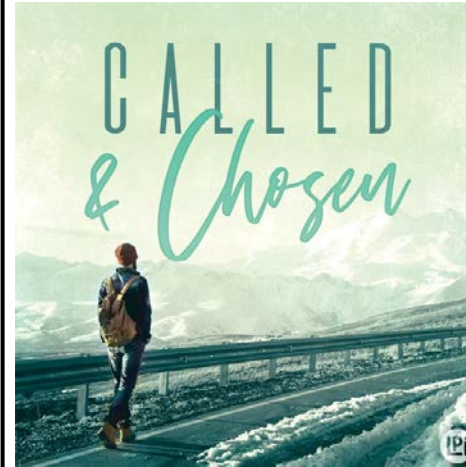
