**Message from Father Tom:**

In Europe it is very common to find building designed with a courtyard in the middle. It's an elegant solution in places where a lot of people live together. Inside this walled garden, people can find peace as they observe the beauty of the manicured plants, while sitting in the sun, protected from the wind.

In our daily readings this week, we have started reading through Genesis. Something easily missed is the love God had in placing us in a garden. This world that we exist in is a protected place, sheltered from the cold between galaxies. It is a place of peace and beauty--can any of us claim not to be awed by a sunset or the millions of stars in the night? And it is a place the Lord has given us for fun--for play. Finally, it is a place given to us to do something wonderful--perhaps raise some crops, or build a business. For all this we should be thankful. We have been placed in a garden.

But along with every blessing we receive are obligations that go along with them. We are to be good stewards of this garden. We are called to tend, protect, and care for the garden. Gifts are not given to us to abuse. What would we think of a farmer who abuses his land for years, then sells it off? Would we not think him extremely selfish and destructive? Although I'm no tree-hugger, we do have a duty to protect and tend the garden we have been given.

Also, because the garden is a free gift to us, we also have an obligation to use it for the benefit of all. In the Church this idea is called the "universal destination of goods." Our goods are destined for universal purposes (the good of all). If we have been given much, it is so that we can in turn give much to our fellow man. Bill Gates wasn't allowed to amass all his wealth for his own pleasure: it was because the Lord intends him to use it for the good of all. Why has the Lord chosen to give you the wealth that you have?

We have been given the gift of a wondrous garden. Let us tend it, and distribute its gifts as the Father asks us.

**CFSA Announcement Weekend:**

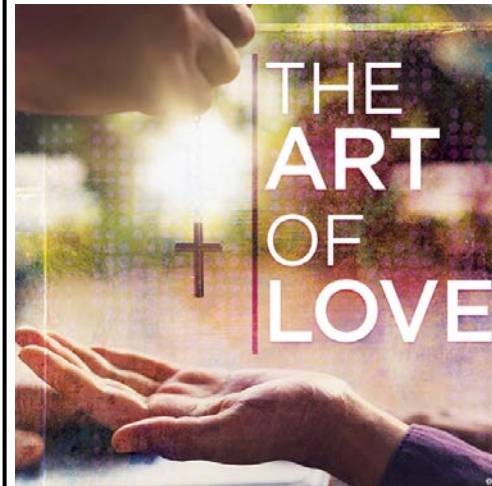
