Message from Father Tom:

"This is what you shall tell the Israelites: I AM sent me to you."

Truly, God IS. He is all around us at every moment. He is in us for He knows us better than we know ourselves. In some ways, it is imprecise to call out for God to come to us...He is already here. Really, what we do in prayer is come to understand better "the Presence of God".

Brother Lawrence (1614-1691) is famous for the booklet The Practice of the Presence of God. He entered a monastery in France and lived the remaining 30 years of his life working in the kitchen, cooking meals and washing pots and pans. He lived in obscurity, yet his desire was to walk continually in God's presence. "There is not in the world a kind of life more sweet and delightful," he said, "than that of a continual conversation with God; those only can comprehend it who practice and experience it.... I believe that all spiritual life consists of practicing God's presence, and that anyone who practices it correctly will soon attain spiritual fulfillment."

Brother Lawrence found God in the monastery kitchen. Amid the boring chores of cooking and cleaning, at the constant bidding of his superiors, he writes, "Men invent means and methods of coming at God's love, they learn rules and set up devices to remind them of that love, and it seems like a world of trouble to bring oneself into the consciousness of God's presence. Yet it might be so simple. Is it not quicker and easier just to do our common business wholly for the love of him?"

Let us today notice the One who IS. Let us do everything for and with Him.
