Message from Father Tom:

“Look at me!”

There was a woman who wrote a book some years ago describing the long arduous task of bringing her child back from the condition of Autism. It is not true of all cases, but apparently some children, if worked with soon enough, and intensely enough, can be helped to overcome their autism. This woman's child was one such a case.

Now autism is a condition in which the person with it has trouble acknowledging the other person: they tend to live in their own little world, and get anxious when they are forced to interact. The treatment that is almost universally prescribed for children in this case is that someone--preferably the parents--force them to look into their eyes before they do almost any activity. So if they have to get ready to go out, the parent might say, “Look at me! I want you to put your shoes on so that we can go. Okay?” By doing so, the child has no choice but to learn to encounter the other.

Why do I bring all this up? Because most of us are born with a condition of *spiritual* autism. We tend to stay in our own little world, ignoring the spiritual movements of God around us--the way that the Holy Spirit is gently pulling on our hearts; the way that the Father is loving us right now at this moment; the way that Christ is really there in the people we encounter. The remedy is also the same--God the Father is constantly crying out to us, “Look at me!” In each one of us, he is trying to bring us back from our self-centered, spiritual autism.

In the midst of a culture that increasingly draws our eyes to different screens (on our phones or in our living rooms), we need to make an effort--not just sometimes, but all throughout our day--to “look at Him” who opens up our eyes to a larger spiritual reality.
