Message from Father Tom:

"I have many more things to tell you, but they would be too much for you now. When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you to all truth."

This time between Christ's Ascension and the descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost is a special time. In it we become particularly aware of the fact that we need something. We need the Holy Spirit. The disciples felt as though they were being abandoned by the Lord. How would they be able to do all that the Lord had commanded them?

Those of us who have grown up Catholic almost certainly learned the list of the gifts and fruits of the Holy Spirit. The normal list of gifts is: Understanding, Knowledge, Wisdom, Counsel, Piety, Fortitude, and Fear of the Lord. *The gifts dispose us to be amenable to God's promptings in our lives.* The list of fruits—intended by St. Paul to only be a sampling—has commonly included: Love, Joy, Peace, Patience, Kindness, Generosity, Fidelity, Meekness, and Continence. *The fruits are the consequences of allowing the Holy Spirit to have control.*

We are well aware of what God has commanded us and know that we have a difficult task ahead. Yet, I think that we become most aware of our need for these gifts and fruits when we observe others who have them. We might think, "How is it that he can always be so at peace? He has a smile for everyone." Or another might say, "She seemed to know more about God than anyone I know, but she never graduated from High School." Those who have the gifts and fruits are truly other-worldly, they are super-natural. They may even be a bit disturbing to us: "He's too generous. A person just can't live like that."

In truth, the task for us is too big. We need the gifts of the Holy Spirit. We need Pentecost. Let us pray for coming of the Spirit this week into our hearts.
