Message from Father Tom:

"Jesus doesn't want me. I'm not good enough to tell others about the good news. I'm too weak--too much of a sinner." Don't we all feel this way?

Jesus choose the 12 apostles: Peter, Andrew, James, John, Phillip, Bartholomew, Thomas, Matthew, etc...Truly, he didn't choose them because they were perfect: Peter was known to be rash and quick of temper. John had the tendency to be reclusive, preferring to spend time dreaming rather than interacting with people. Thomas was about as stubborn as they come. Bartholomew's words were often critical and biting. Judas, of course, could be incurably greedy and frequently sought his own comfort rather than the well-being of those around him. In other words, they were all very normal people that Jesus chose.

Today, Jesus chooses normal people: people with weaknesses, people who occasionally fall. He doesn't call you to follow him because you are worthy. He makes worthy the ones that He calls. Trust that!
