Message from Father Tom:

Top 5 things to do about our fallen away children and grandchildren.

1. Never give up on them. After years of trying to talk to my family members about things of faith, it is tempting to stop asking if they would like to come to mass with me. Yet, I continue to invite them to a variety of faith related things... trying to be as little annoying as possible.
2. Pray. Never forget that St. Augustine seemed like a lost cause to many who saw how he lived. Yet he became one of the greatest of saints because of the prayers of his mother. I have personally witnessed a close friend of mine come to the faith after years of praying for her. Pray the rosary. Offer masses. Get together with friends to intercede for those you love.
3. Be a witness of joy and hope. One of the biggest turn-offs to the faith is what some have dubbed the "sour-faced saint". These are the people who are faithful, but look absolutely miserable in the process. A motto that I try to live by is: "the surest sign of holiness is thankfulness." A true saint is one who always has a reason to smile; because he or she knows that God is truly amazing. Is there anything about your life that is attractive?
4. Talk about the Church and your relationship to God. We must be prepared to give a reason for our joy and hope. Although witnessing with joy and hope are very important, people need to make the connection to our faith life. Too many people never talk about the ways God is blessing them in the Church.
5. Remember that God loves them even more than you do. Ultimately, worry is not of the Lord. Hope IS of the Lord. We trust in a God who created us, who redeemed us, and who loves us. If He is all-powerful and He loves our children that much, how could He NOT prevail over them? So let's be patient and trust.
