Message from Father Tom:

In France in the 1700s we might have expected to find a great saint somewhere in one of the famous monasteries, from which had come so many great mystics. We might have looked at one of the Cathedrals, where liturgy led the people into a semblance of heaven as they looked at stain-glass windows and heard choirs. We might have looked to the great University of Paris, where so many Doctors of the Church had taught and wrote about Christ. Instead, St. John Vianney could be found in a tiny town in rural France.

A few days ago we celebrated St. John Vianney. Saint John Vianney was amazing in his own way; but what was so remarkable about him is **how ordinary he was**. He was no great intellect--he had trouble learning Latin at a time when you needed to know Latin to be a priest. He was (we think) not very well spoken--it was only his great conviction that made his words powerful. He was not from some great family--he grew up a simple farmer. Yet, he has such a great love for God and such a great love for the people that it didn't matter. By the time he had died, people were streaming to Ars, France to see the saint.

Ars was probably about the size of our little towns. The Lord wants us to know that we can be saints. By God's grace we can love Him more fully and love one another more fully. Let us ask St. John Vianney to pray that a saint (or many) can rise up from a tiny little community in South Dakota.

October 3rd – Family Formation at 5:45pm in the Parish Hall.

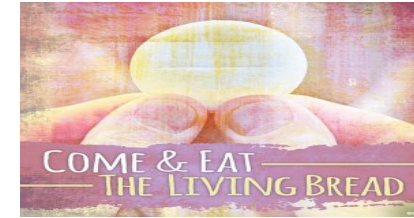
