**Message from Father Tom:**

This is the will of God, your holiness: that you refrain from immorality, that each of you know how to acquire a wife for himself in holiness and honor, not in lustful passion [...] [Do not] take advantage of or exploit a brother or sister in this matter, [...] For God did not call us to impurity but to holiness. Therefore, whoever disregards this, disregards not a human being but God... -1 Thes 4

I try not to preach all that often about sexual sin. Not because they are not significant or dangerous. They certainly are. I don't address them very often, first, because I think people generally know the teachings of the Church. Namely:

- Sex before marriage is a grave sin.
- Pornography and/or masturbation make someone unfit to receive communion and they should seek confession.
- Adultery, intimacy with someone-not-your-spouse, is against the 6th commandment.
- Remarriage without an annulment is not allowed.

For the most part, people know the laws of the Church. They just have difficulty keeping them.

Another reason I don't address them very often is because these sins are often the fruit (or the end result) of selfishness and godlessness rather than the cause of them. As such, I often try to work on the roots of the problem--namely selfishness and godlessness. When people draw closer to God and they get better and better at thinking of others, impurity will often become less of a problem.

But all that being said, I wish to remind you that they are, in fact, sins. And they are grave sins at that.

One question we may have is "where did the Church get all this?" The passage quoted above from St. Paul's first letter to the Thessalonians illustrates how this teaching has been part of the Church from the beginning. Already in his day, St. Paul was coming across Christians dealing with impurity. He gently, but clearly reminded them that they needed to avoid impurity and lustful passion. They should not take advantage or exploit people for their lust. And the one who disregard this, is actually disregarding the Lord himself.

May the Lord grant us freedom from impurity. May we treat one another with pure minds and heart, valuing our brothers and sisters as beloved sons and daughters of God.
